Nashville Fall Foliage and Gaylord Opryland

WITH CROSSINGS COMMUNITY CHURCH

Day 1 – Today we head to Tennessee as we get acquainted with our traveling companions and enjoy the countryside with its fall colors. Our overnight this evening is in Memphis at a Drury Inn where we can enjoy their lite dinner and snacks or choose to visit a local restaurant.

Day 2 – After a **continental breakfast** at the hotel we depart Memphis and travel across hillsides and valleys painted with a pallet of autumn colors as we head to Nashville, the capitol of Tennessee and known as Music City USA. This afternoon we begin our time in Nashville at the **Country Music Hall of Fame & Museum** full of rhinestone costumes, instruments and interactive exhibits that will let us see and live the experience. Then visit **Trinity Music City** where TBN broadcasts “Praise The Lord” from their high definition TV station. We will journey through a recreation of the Via Dolorosa, an ancient street in the old walled city of Jerusalem while touring Trinity Music City. Our next two nights are at the **The Gaylord Opryland Resort** with rooms that overlook the atrium with private balconies. With nine acres of indoor gardens and cascading waterfalls there is much to see and do. Spend time exploring the shops, taking a flatboat ride on the Delta River, dining in one of the properties restaurants, or enjoying a leisurely evening walk in the gardens. **(CB)**

Day 3 – Breakfast is on our own this morning before we began the day with a **city tour of Nashville**. Our local guide will get us acquainted with Nashville as we hear history, tales and see historic sites. We’ll visit the **Ryman Museum** to learn about The Ryman Auditorium and the stars that have graced its stage over the last 100 years. **Lunch is aboard the General Jackson Showboat** where we will enjoy one of their world class shows while cruising the Cumberland River. This afternoon return to the Gaylord Opryland for free time to enjoy the complex or visit **Opry Mills** with more than 200 restaurants, stores and entertainment venues. Dinner is on our own before we take our seats at the **Grand Ole Opry**. What began as a simple radio broadcast in 1925 today is a phenomenon music venue which honors many dynamic country music performers. After the show we will do a behind the scenes tour of the Grand Ole Opry before returning to the Gaylord Opryland for our overnight. **(L)**

Day 4 – Breakfast is on our own before departing the Opryland and traveling to **Graceland** to experience life as Elvis did with an audio-guided tour of Graceland Mansion. See videos, photos, personal mementos and artifacts, movie memorabilia, stage costumes, Elvis’ two airplanes, the new Elvis in Hollywood exhibit and much more. Our overnight is in Memphis at a Drury with a lite dinner provided at the hotel.

Day 5 – **Continental breakfast included** at the hotel before we depart the hotel and head to **St Judes** and visit the **Danny Thomas Pavilion** to learn more about the life of Thomas as an entertainer and founder of St Jude Children’s Research Hospital. We return back in Oklahoma with many memories of our fall trip to Nashville. **(CB)**
