Colossians 3:17	Christ-Centered	And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.
Galatians 2:20	Christ-Centered	I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.
Luke 9:23-24	Christ-Centered	If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me. For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me will save it.
Matthew 6:33	Christ-Centered	But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.
Hebrews 10:24-25	Community	And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds. Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another - and all the more as you see the Day approaching.
Acts 2:42-43	Community	They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. Everyone was filled with awe, and many wonders and miraculous signs were done by the apostles.
Acts 2:44-45	Community	All the believers were together and had everything in common. Selling their possessions and goods, they gave to anyone as he had need.
Acts 2:46-47	Community	Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.
John 1:12-13	Faith & Trust	Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God - children not born of natural descent, nor of human decision or a husband's will, but born of God.
Proverbs 3:5-6	Faith & Trust	Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean no on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make your paths straight.

Romans 4:20-21	Faith & Trust	Yet he did not waver through unbelief regarding the promise of God, but was strengthened in his faith and gave glory to God, being fully persuaded that God had power to do what he had promised.
James 2:26	Faith & Trust	As the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without deeds is dead.
Isaiah 26:3	God's Love & Peace	You will keep in perfect peace him whose mind is steadfast, because he trusts in you.
John 3:16-17	God's Love & Peace	For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him.
Lamentations 3:22-23	God's Love & Peace	Because of the LORD's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. The are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.
Philippians 4:6-7	God's Love & Peace	Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.
1 Corinthians 2:12	God's Spirit & Strength	We have not received the spirit of the world but the Spirit who is from God, that we may understand what God has freely given us.
2 Timothy 1:7	God's Spirit & Strength	For God did not give us a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of power, of love and of self-discipline.
Galatians 5:22-23	God's Spirit & Strength	But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. Against such things there is no law.
Isaiah 41:10	God's Spirit & Strength	So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.
2 Timothy 3:16-17	God's Word & Witness	All scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

Matthew 28:19-20	God's Word & Witness	Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.
Psalms 119:11	God's Word & Witness	I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you.
Romans 1:16	God's Word & Witness	I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes.
1 Corinthians 13:4-8	Love & Obedience	Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. Love never fails.
John 13:34-35	Love & Obedience	A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.
Matthew 22:37-39	Love & Obedience	Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: Love your neighbor as yourself.
Matthew 5:44-45	Love & Obedience	But I tell you: Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, that you may be sons of your Father in heaven.
1 Corinthians 15:58	Perseverance	Therefore, my dear brothers, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain.
Hebrews 12:1	Perseverance	Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles, and let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us.
Hebrews 12:2	Perseverance	Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.
Hebrews 12:3	Perseverance	Consider him who endured such opposition from sinful men, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart.

1 Corinthians 6:18-20	Purity	Flee from sexual immorality. All other sins a man commits are outside his body, but he who sins sexually sins against his own body. Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your body.
Acts 24:16	Purity	So I strive always to keep my conscience clear before God and man.
Ephesians 4:29	Purity	Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen.
Leviticus 19:11	Purity	Do not steal. Do not lie. Do not deceive one another.
2 Corinthians 9:6-7	Service & Generosity	Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. Each man should give what he has decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.
Mark 10:45	Service & Generosity	For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.
Philippians 2:3-5	Service & Generosity	Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves. Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others. Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus.
Proverbs 11:25	Service & Generosity	A generous man will prosper; he who refreshes others will himself be refreshed.
1 Peter 3:18	Sin & The Cross	For Christ died for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God. He was put to death in the body but made alive by the Spirit.
Ephesians 2:8-9	Sin & The Cross	For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith - and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God - not by works, so that no one can boast.

Isaiah 53:6	Sin & The Cross	We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way; and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all.
Romans 5:8	Sin & The Cross	But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
1 Corinthians 10:13	The World & Temptation	No temptation has seized you except what is common to man. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can stand up under it.
1 Peter 2:11	The World & Temptation	Dear friends, I urge you, as aliens and strangers in the world, to abstain from sinful desires, which war against your soul.
Genesis 4:7	The World & Temptation	If you do what is right, will you not be accepted? But if you do not do what is right, sin is crouching at your door; it desires to have you, but you must master it.
Romans 12:2	The World & Temptation	Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is - his good, pleasing and perfect will.
1 Corinthians 10:31	Worship	So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God.
1 Peter 2:9	Worship	But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.
Psalms 118:24	Worship	This is the day the LORD has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it.
Romans 12:1	Worship	Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God - this is your reasonable act of worship.
