# Washington DC



**September 18-29, 2008**

**Day 1** – We depart Crossings Community Church at 7:30 am this morning and spend the day getting acquainted with our travel companions and settle in for a wonderful adventure that takes us thru eleven states. This afternoon we will enjoy **lunch and a tour at Heifer Ranch** and learn of their work with communities to end hunger and poverty. Our overnight this evening is in Memphis, TN. **(L)**

**Day 2** – **Continental breakfast included** at the hotel this morning. Today we travel to Chattanooga, the origins of that forgettable song “Chattanooga Choo Choo”. This afternoon we will take a ride unlike any other as we board the **Incline Railway** at Lookout Mountain. We will ride the world’s steepest passenger railway up historic Lookout Mountain where we find a spectacular view from the observation deck. Overnight in Chattanooga, TN. **(CB)**

**Day 3** – Enjoy a **continental breakfast** before we depart Chattanooga and head to North Carolina. This afternoon we visit **Biltmore Estates** where lunch is on our own at the Stable Café



before we tour the gardens and house. As we tour this 250-room family home of George and Edith Vanderbilt we discover original art from masters such as Renoir, magnificent 16<sup>th</sup> century tapestries, a library with 10,000 volumes, an indoor pool, bowling alley and priceless antiques. This French Renaissance chateau remains America’s largest privately owned home. Visit the gardens and arboretum designed by Olmsted who also designed Central Park in NYC. Our overnight this evening is in Asheville, NC. **(CB)**

**Day 4** – After our **continental breakfast** at the hotel we will spend the day with fun on the coach as we travel to Colonial Williamsburg, VA for our overnight. **(CB)**

**Day 5** – A **continental breakfast** is provided at the hotel before we depart for a **guided tour of Colonial Williamsburg**. We will step back in time and experience what it was like 200 years ago. With more than 500 restored and reconstructed buildings and a staff of historical interpreters Colonial Williamsburg presents a unique experience unlike any other. **Lunch is included** in Colonial Williamsburg. This afternoon return to the hotel for some rest and relaxation or head downtown for some sightseeing and shopping in Williamsburg. **(CB,L)**



**Day 6** – **Continental breakfast included** at the hotel before we continue traveling to our nation's capitol. Our time in DC begins with an afternoon at the **Smithsonian Institution**, the world's largest museum complex. Since it is impossible to visit all fourteen museums on one visit, pick a few to visit and save the rest for your next trip to DC. We will overnight the next three nights in Springfield, VA. **(CB)**

**Day 7 & 8** – **Continental breakfast** at the hotel each morning before we begin our **guided tour of Washington DC**. Our sightseeing the next two days will include: the **Jefferson Memorial**, where we find a 19-foot bronze statue of the third president of the United States; the **FDR Memorial**, consisting of four out door "gallery" rooms featuring sculptures depicting the life and times of President Franklin D. Roosevelt; the **Korean Memorial**; the **Vietnam Veterans Memorial**; the **Lincoln Memorial**; the new **World War II Memorial**; the **Washington Monument**; and **Arlington National Cemetery**. This sacred, 500-acre site is the final resting place for President John F Kennedy, Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis, space shuttle Challenger astronauts, and thousands



of soldiers from every major US war. **(CB)**

**Day 9** – **Continental breakfast** included this morning before we depart for Charlottesville VA. This morning we explore the house, gardens, and plantation of **Monticello**, the mountaintop home of Thomas Jefferson, the third president of the United States and author of the Declaration of Independence. Next we enjoy an included **lunch and tour at Michie Tavern**, where southern hospitality prevails. We'll enjoy a hearty midday fare offered by servers in period attire before touring this landmark. The original tavern and its dependent outbuildings recreate 18<sup>th</sup> century life. This evening we overnight in Charleston, WV. **(CB, L)**



**Day 10** – A **continental breakfast** is provided at the hotel before boarding coach and head to Kentucky. This afternoon we visit the **Kentucky Derby Museum** where the sounds, images, and artifacts bring the famous Kentucky Derby to life. We will have time to freshen up at the hotel before departing for **dinner and entertainment** at the **Derby Dinner Playhouse**. **(CB, D)**

**Day 11** – **Continental breakfast included** this morning at the hotel. Our travel today takes us thru Illinois and into Missouri where lunch is included in Kimmswick, MO at the **Blue Owl Restaurant** that has been featured on the Paula Dean Show. After lunch we will have time to explore this small community with over 20 unique shops, many located in historical homes and buildings dating back to the mid 1800's. Then we will visit the **Gateway Arch** the nation's tallest man-made monument standing 630 feet. We are on our own to explore the Lewis & Clark museum or take a tram ride to the top. Our overnight this evening is in St Louis. **(CB, L)**

**Day 12** – **Continental breakfast included** at the hotel this morning before we begin our final day of travel and arrive back home. Today we'll say goodbye to our traveling friends as we return home with many memories of our time in Washington DC. **(CB)**
